

“Got Stick? Outshoot Slapshot Shawn”

Take a shot for a chance to win a free registration to attend the 2017 Annual Meeting in Toronto! During ITE section meetings in the Midwestern District leading up to the district’s conference in Madison, Wisconsin, and during the 2017 Midwestern District Conference, individuals will have an opportunity to outshoot “Slapshot” Shawn! Individuals who want to try to score on “Slapshot” Shawn again, can do so for a contribution of \$5 for each additional 30-second shooting period, with the proceeds going to the MWITE District Student Activities Fund.

Each individual will have 30 seconds to score as many goals as they can from a distance of 3 feet or more from the goal. The competition will feature a cut out goalie, net and frame as pictured above along with a hockey stick and “no bounce” ball to shoot at the goal.

The individual with the greatest number of goals in the Midwestern District will have their name entered into a drawing along with competition winners from the other ITE Districts. *In case of a tie for the MWITE activity, a drawing will be held with the names of the individuals tied with the greatest number of goals to select the district’s winner.* **The winner of the drawing will receive a free registration to attend the 2017 International ITE Annual Meeting in Toronto.**

The drawing will be held after June 23, 2017. In the event the individual who wins the drawing has already paid for a registration, ITE would reimburse them. This registration can only be used for Toronto and is not transferrable.
